TENDER NOTICE

MODERNIZATION AND RENOVATION OF EXISTING MILK BOOTHS OF DMS.

1. For & on behalf of President of India, General Manager, Delhi Milk Scheme, invites sealed tenders from the interested parties / firms / companies for modernization and renovation of milk booths as per terms and conditions specified in the tender documents in lieu of rights for utilization of available space (on all walls except front wall) of milk booths for publicity and advertisement for a fixed period of three years.
2. There are about 600 DMS milk booths (existing plus new sites) situated at various locations all over Delhi. Initially about 200 such booths shall be covered under this project. All walls accept front wall of the booth can be used by the tenderer for generation of income by utilizing the space for advertisement/ publicity. The tenderer should have sound financial background (capable of investing around 5 crores of Rupees in the Project) and rich experience in management of selling the space of advertisement and publicity and providing service of civil / electrical maintenance and construction work. The tenderer should have a turn over of Rs.5 crores annually during last three years. The financial status / rating shall be duly certified by Chartered Accountant / firm. This will constitute the part of the technical bid of the tender.
3. The construction of milk booths shall be of high standard and as per the specification and design furnished by DMS and the same shall be completed in a fixed time frame. The successful tenderer shall also carry out the maintenance of booths during the period of contract for which the tenderer will be allowed to use all walls (except front wall) of the constructed booths for publicity and advertisement business.
4. The tenderer will also be required to dismantle the existing booth structure, remove malba and debris, dispose of the same and rebuilt the booths. Before the construction the tenderer will have to obtain necessary permission from the Ministry of Urban Development / MCD / Delhi Government / Civic Bodies etc. for construction and advertisement on booths at their own expense. Further whatever the laid down procedure or stipulations of the Hon'ble court in the case of hoarding / advertising etc. pending before Hon'ble Supreme Court, as the case may be will be followed by the tenderer at his own cost.

5. The interested parties / firms / companies may purchase tender documents from General Section of Delhi Milk Scheme (Room No.50) on any working day from **23.4.2012** up to **23.5.2012** between 10.00 A.M. and 1.00 P.M. by depositing Rs.500/- in cash (non refundable). Before submission of Technical & Commercial bids the interested parties may attend Pre bid conference with DMS officials on **31.5.2012** in room No.59, D.M.S., Admn. Block at 11.00 A.M. The tenders (Technical & Commercial Bids) will be placed in separate sealed covers duly earmarked. The Technical and commercial bids will then be placed in a single envelope and submitted. The bids will be received up to 2.00 PM on **8.6.2012** and thereafter the same shall be opened at 3.30 PM in Committee Hall (Room No.59). The interested parties may attend the tender opening on the said date, time & venue. Tender received late or without EMD will be summarily rejected.
